Eleanor Campbell Charitable Foundation scholarships are awarded to students who will be attending post secondary school full-time who attend Hillsborough-Deering High School, John Stark High School *or* other accredited secondary schools *or* are or were home schooled, *and/or* are residents of Deering, Hillsborough and Weare. Scholarships are granted based upon a student's academic achievement, financial need, citizenship, career choice, quality of personal statement, school activities and recommendations. Qualified students are eligible for up to two annual awards during their post secondary education years.
